Dear Partners in Christ:

This Prayer Letter focuses on (1) Prayer for Haiti, (2) Letter from the orphans in Liberia, (3) Christian High School, (4) Convention 2009-held by Church of the Believers, and (5) Items of praise & prayer.

Prayer for Haiti: The 7.0 magnitude Earthquake in Haiti resulted to the destruction of billions of dollars in property, the lost of 200,000 lives, and the displacement of over three million people in one day. The good news is, *God is good at bringing something great out of evil.* The enslavement of Joseph in Egypt by his brothers brought forth victory for him and the people of Egypt (Gen. chapters, 37;41-49). We, at AICM, believe that, the tears of Haiti will turn to glorious joy as the world comes to the long overdue rescue of that beloved country. We call on all our partners and friends to continue to pray for Haiti and her people.

Letter from the Orphans: On behalf of the orphans of Liberia under the auspices of AICM, we say thanks for your continual support. Attached to this prayerletter is a hand-written letter emailed to us signed by designated orphans on behalf of the orphanages we support. The letter is self-explanatory.

Pray for Christian High School in Monrovia: For their 2008-2009 graduation, 127 students graduated from the school. Many of these graduates have enrolled at the University of Liberia. The school also started with 550 students for academic 2009-2010. Thanks for your support.

Convention 2009 (Dec. 7-13): Church of the Believers Convention 2009 was hosted by Pastor Prince Bantoe of Geyah Church of the Believers, Inc. in Lower Nimba County Liberia. Sixteen churches participated, in the conference, with our 300 delegates.

Praise Report: The children at our three orphanages in Liberia are well and in school. One of them, Dee Woryon-won was seriously sick; but praise God he is healed and back at Koko Children's Village.

Items for prayer: (1) Koko Children's Village needs one 6KVA generator (\$1,250.00). The one they had, for over four years, was damaged beyond repair. Presently, the children are in darkness. Due to the fourteen years civil war, electricity has not been restored in the City of Monrovia and its environs. The only means of light is generator. (2) We have lost support for 25 orphans due to the prevailing financial constraint in the country. Pray that new good-hearted Christians will stand to replace those that had stopped given. To support a child is \$20.00 per month.
